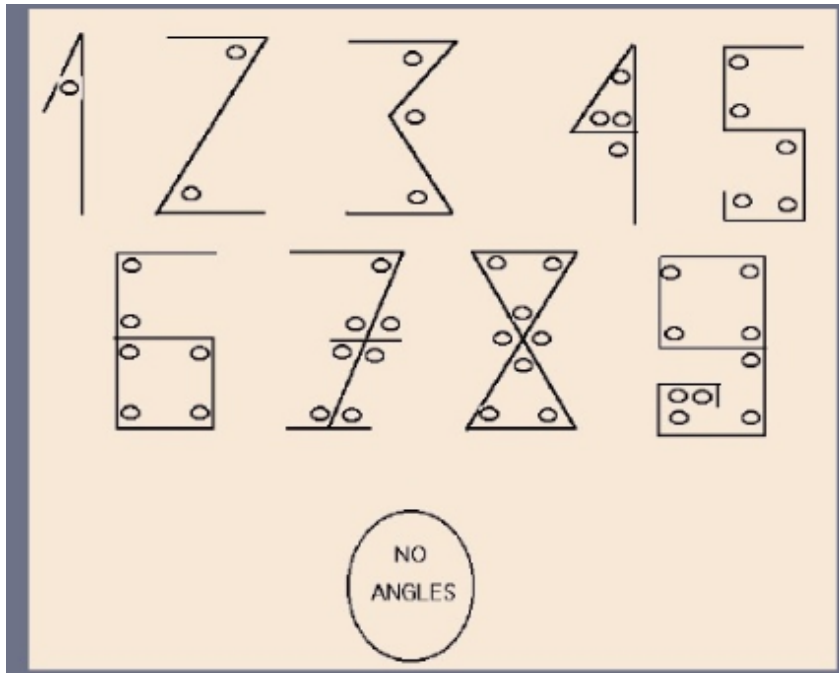
POST IT FUN:
